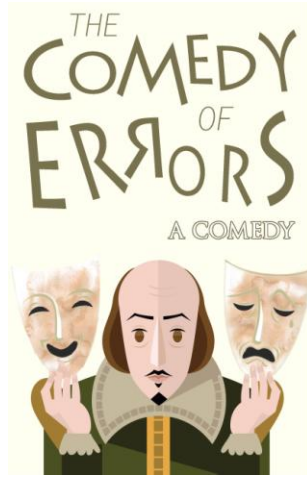


Audition Notice

We are looking for men and women of high school age or older. A prepared classical monologue or soliloquy is preferred but not required. There are a variety of roles both big and small and opportunities for non speaking roles. If you wish to be involved we probably have a role for you.

Main speaking roles:

Antipholus of Syracuse: Male aged 25 to 35, the twin brother to Antipholus of Ephesus, he has been traveling with his servant Dromio looking for their long lost brothers.

Antipholus of Ephesus: Male aged 25 to 35, the twin brother to Antipholus of Syracuse, a well respected merchant in Ephesus and husband of Adriana.

Dromio of Syracuse: Maled aged 25 to 35, the twin brother to Dromio of Ephesus, servant to Antipholus of Syracuse he is a witty yet bumbling character with lots of opportunity for slapstick hilarity. Looking for physical, comical talent.

Dromio of Ephesus: Maled aged 25 to 35, the twin brother to Dromio of Syracuse, servant to Antipholus of Ephesus he is a witty yet bumbling character with lots of opportunity for slapstick hilarity. Looking for physical, comical talent.

Adriana: Female aged 20 to 30, wife of Antipholus of Ephesus, a frustrated woman who feels spurned by her husband whom she believes is not being faithful.

Luciana:

Female aged 20 to 30, sister of Adriana, who both tries to calm her sister and protect her.

Egeon: Male aged 45 to 70, the father of Antipholus of Ephesus and Antipholus of Syracuse, he has spent the past few years searching for his lost wife and son and now faces execution in Ephesus.

Duke Solinus: Male aged 30 to 70, Duke of Ephesus.

Angelo: Male aged 30 to 50, a well respected goldsmith in Ephesus and friend of Antipholus of Ephesus.

Aemilia: Female aged 45 to 70, the mother of Antipholus of Ephesus and Antipholus of Syracuse, after the loss of her family she became a nun.

Cortezan: Female aged 20 to 40, a sometimes consort of Antipholus of Ephesus and the proprietor of the Porpentine.

Balthazar: Male aged 25 to 50, a merchant in Ephesus and friend of Angelo and Antipholus of Ephesus.

Pinch: Male aged 40 to 70, a local "doctor" who tries to exercise Antipholus of Ephesus when he is believed to be possessed.

Second Merchant: Male aged 30 to 50, a merchant in Ephesus for business to whom Angelo owes money.

Officer: Male aged 25 to 60, an officer of the law in Ephesus who can be paid to arrest people when they are charged with a crime.

Luce: Female any age, a saucy servant in the household of Antipholus of Ephesus. This character does not appear on stage but has lines from offstage.
